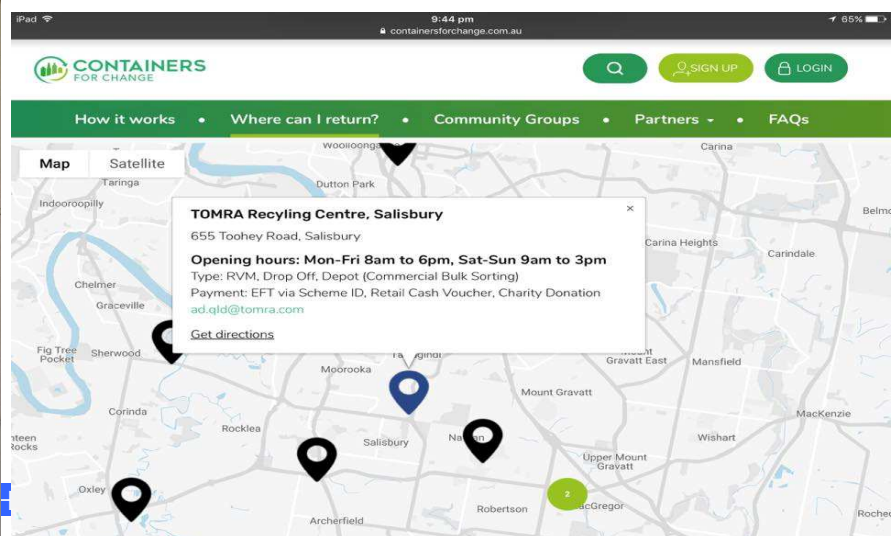

## Uniform Shop:

Volunteers Needed / Peak Times

The Uniform Shop could really do with some help on Wednesday afternoons from 3pm to 3:20pm, and particularly Friday mornings from 8:30am to 9am.

The shop experiences high volumes of customers during these short time spans and sometimes parents need to wait quite a while to be served, due to lack of help.

Email [uniformshopwhss@gmail.com](mailto:uniformshopwhss@gmail.com) beforehand to let us know any days you can help.

Parents - If you do attend the shop during these peak times, please be patient and aware that you will may need to wait. Perhaps consider attending the shop a little earlier than 3pm on a Wednesday, or after 9am on a Friday, when it is way less busy. You will be served a lot faster! Alternatively, if they are able, send your children to the shop on a Wednesday during second break. Staff can assist with sizing and ordering for your child, or order on line, and your child simply has to collect your order.

### Orders for 2019

Please purchase or order any uniform needs for next year BEFORE OR ON WEDNESDAY 12th DECEMBER - THIS IS THE LAST DAY THE UNIFORM SHOP IS OPEN. Orders received after this date cannot be guaranteed to be filled for the start of school next year.

The shop is open for collection Jan 24th/25th 9am to 11am, and Tuesday (first day of school) 1:30pm to 3:30pm. Regular hours will continue after this date.

The shop is CLOSED - FRIDAY 14th DECEMBER.

## Tuckshop:

### TUCKSHOP NEWS.

This term has flown by so if we don't get another opportunity we would like to say a huge THANK YOU to all of our wonderful volunteers. We wouldn't be able to run the tuckshop without your support. We look forward to spending our days with you and we want you to know that you are all very very appreciated and valued as members of the WHSS tuckshop team!!

Unfortunately, we are losing a significant amount of volunteers this year who are leaving the school. We only have 10 volunteers returning to us next year. To run the tuckshop we need 36 VOLUNTEERS – just once a month for about 3 hours in the morning. At the moment we are considering our options for next year as we try to work out a way to operate without spending all of our minimal profit on added staffing expenses. We may have to close for a few days a week, or have a significant price rise or halve our menu options. At the moment it is probably a case of all 3 happening to some extent.

So if you can spare 3 hours per month (usually 9 or 10 times per year) can you please contact us before the end of the school year. Please email or drop in and see us. Many thanks Carolyn, Kimberley and Akane
