Science	Weather watch	
	Students use their senses to explore and observe the weather in their local environment and learn that we can record our observations using symbols.	
	Students observe that weather can change and identify the features that reflect a change in the weather. They are given opportunities to reflect on	
	the impact of these changes on themselves, in particular, on clothing, shelter and activities, through various cultural perspectives. They begin to realise	
	that weather conditions are not the same for everyone. Students also learn about the impact of daily and seasonal changes on plants and animals.	
	Throughout the unit students reflect on how the weather affects living things and have opportunities to communicate their observations about the	
	weather.
