## Our initiatives include



- Develop an expert teaching team, in all year levels across the school) in the Australian Curriculum through reading and writing by employing a Head of Curriculum (Japanese as well as English) to ensure a focussed mentoring and coaching program to ensure the intended curriculum is enacted.
- Support students in all classrooms with additional teacher aides and provide quality professional development to work with teachers.
- Develop teacher capacity in the analysis and discussion of data and how to use it to improve outcomes for all students, through a case management approach (attendance, whole school testing, NAPLAN, Australian Curriculum A-E data) to inform teaching and learning for all students.
