Initiative: Improved Student Outcomes for all students in the areas of Literacy and Numeracy.

The strategies used and resources purchased through the 2017 I4S allocation allowed the Principal and staff to focus on improving the classroom pedagogy, the resources available to staff and students and the professional development available to staff.


Internal school measures indicate that students are improving in all areas across the curriculum. External measures, NAPLAN, also supports this premise.

- Enhancement of the Japanese Bilingual Programme through administration support and in-country study.


Our initiatives include
